After questions about the request and discussion among the IEC, <u>Stanley John motions to approve \$2,448.34 to purchase the nine (9) drums for the DVI Music program from Line Item 312</u>. Desiree Fowler seconds. Vote to approve 4, opposed 0 and none abstained. Motion approved.
- 3. Mary Hesse, Page Middle School Orchestra teacher, requests \$4,686.31 to purchase 20 string instruments and 25 Shoulder Rests for their program.
